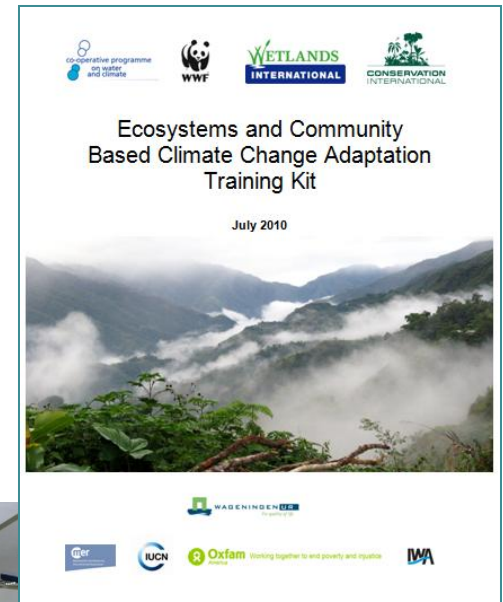

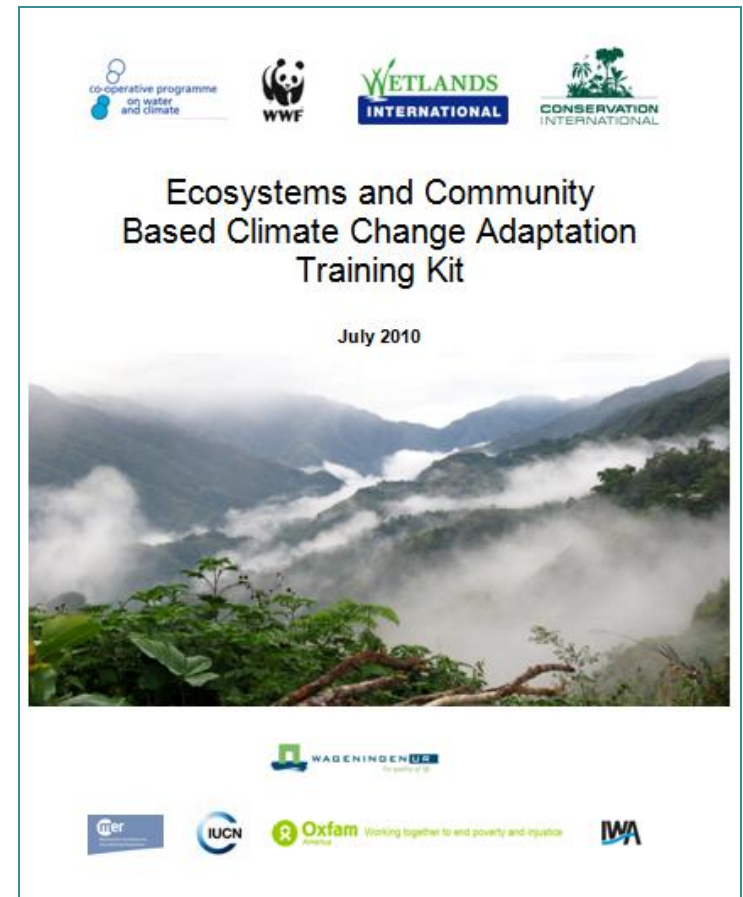


A - Background to Training of Trainers

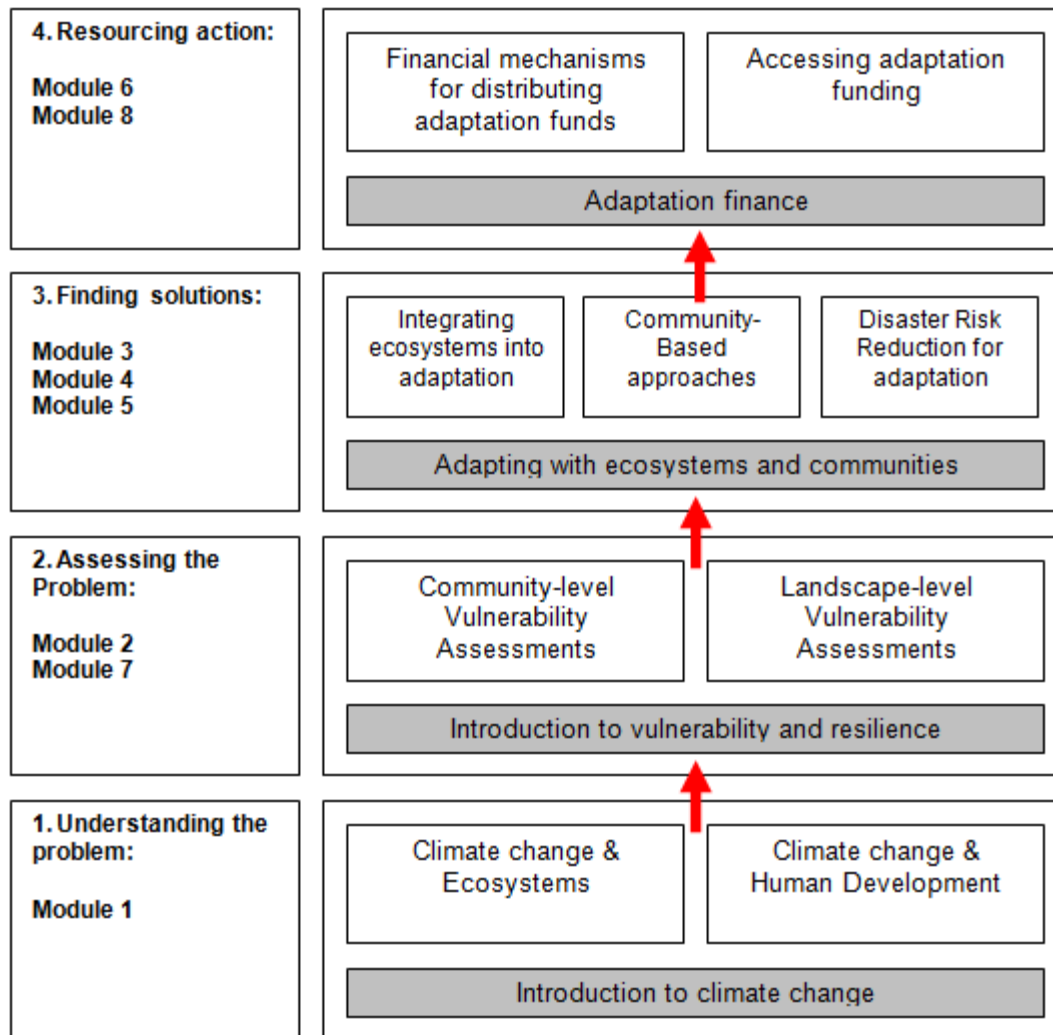
- **Partnership between Wetlands International, WWF (US) and Conservation International**
- **Wetlands International secured funding for 1 year pilot**
- **Targets conservation and development practitioners with training responsibilities**
- **Delivered twice to date: West/East African Countries in Kenya(May 2010), Asian Countries in India (August 2010)**
- **3rd Delivery planned for South America: Likely Panama in December 2010/January 2011**
- **Joint fundraising underway for revision/future delivery**

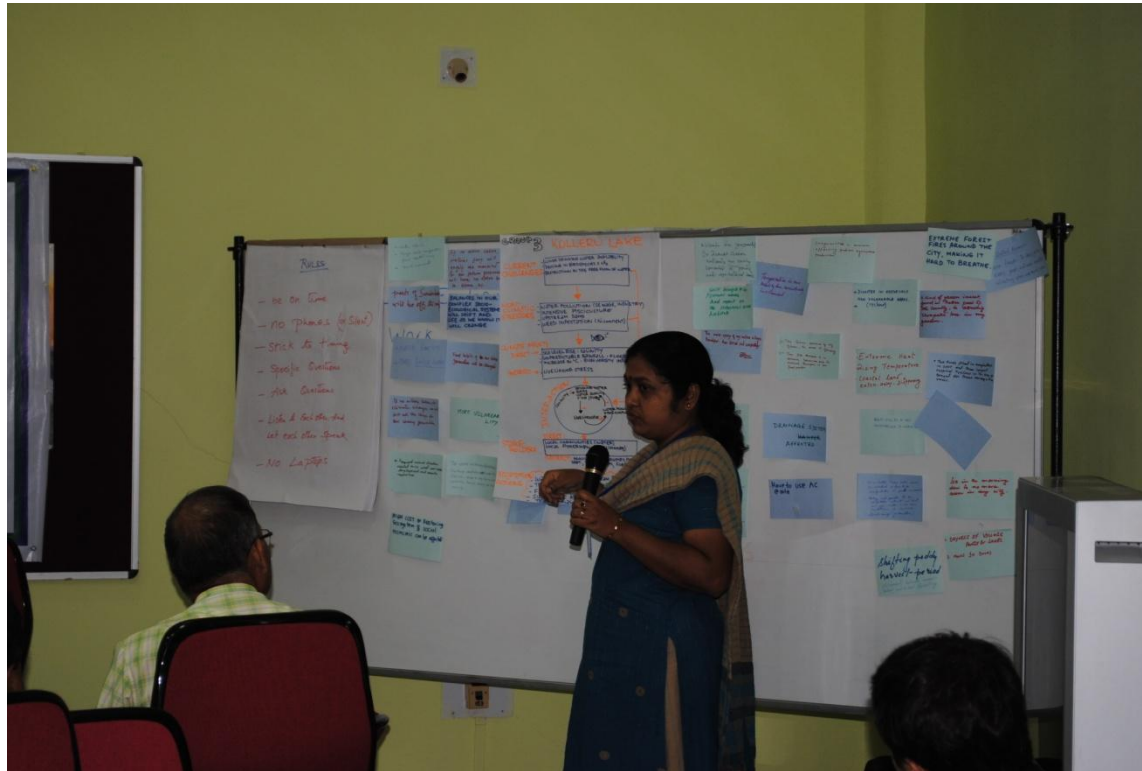
Training Structure
